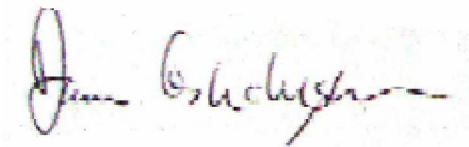
On September 12, 2000, Mr. [REDACTED] wrote to advise us he had chosen a new representative.

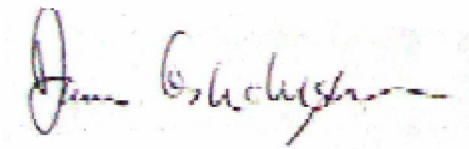
